2 **AP 3530 WEAPONS ON CAMPUS**

4 Penal Code Sections 626.9, 626.10, and 12020

5 Firearms, knives, explosives, or other dangerous objects, including but not limited to
6 any facsimile firearm, knife, or explosive, are prohibited on all District property or any
7 facility used for District purposes.

8 Activities involving firearms or other weapons conducted under the direction of District
9 officials or as authorized by an official law enforcement agency shall be reported to the
10 Palomar College Police Department before taking place.

11 Any person who believes that he/she may properly possess a firearm or other weapon
12 on campus or in a District center or other facility of the District must promptly notify the
13 Palomar College Police Department.

14 Bringing or possessing any dirk, dagger, ice pick, or knife having a fixed blade longer
15 than 2 1/2 inches upon the grounds is forbidden, unless the person is authorized to
16 possess such a weapon in the course of his/her employment, has been authorized by a
17 District employee to have the knife, or is a duly appointed peace officer, who is engaged
18 in the performance of his/her duties.
