

GOVERNING BOARD

BP 2720 COMMUNICATIONS AMONG GOVERNING BOARD MEMBERS

Reference:

Government Code Section 54952.2

Members of the Governing Board shall not communicate among themselves by the use of any form of communication (e.g., personal intermediaries, e-mail, or other technological device) in order to reach a collective concurrence regarding any item that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Governing Board.

A majority of the members of the Governing Board shall not, outside of an official Board Meeting, use a series of communications of any kind, directly or through intermediaries, to discuss, deliberate, or take action on any item of business that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Governing Board.

This policy shall not be construed as preventing an employee or official of the District, from engaging in separate conversations or communications, outside of a meeting, with members of the Governing Board in order to answer questions or provide information regarding a matter that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Governing Board, if that person does not communicate to members of the Governing Board the comments or position of any other member or members of the Governing Board.

Except for the conditions of this policy, individual contacts or conversations between members of the Governing Board and any other person are not constrained.
