2 **BP 6540 INSURANCE**

4 Education Code Sections 70902, 72502, 72506, and 81601 et seq.

5 The Superintendent/President shall be responsible to secure insurance for the District
6 as required by law, which shall include but is not limited to the liabilities described in
7 Education Code Section 72506 as follows:

- 8 • Liability for damages for death, injury to persons, or damage or loss of property
- 9 • Personal liability of the members of the Governing Board and the officers and
10 employees of the District for damages for death, injury to a person, or damage or
11 loss of property caused by the negligent act or omission of the member, officer,
12 or employee when acting within the scope of his or her office or employment.
13 The Superintendent/President may authorize coverage for persons who perform
14 volunteer services for the District
- 15 • Worker’s compensation insurance

16 Insurance also shall include fire insurance and insurance against other perils
17 recommended by the Finance and Administrative Services Office.

18 The District may join in a joint powers agreement pursuant to Education Code Section
19 81603 for the purposes described in this policy.
