Students must have the College Board send an official Advanced Placement transcript to the Palomar College Records Office.

Course credit and units granted at Palomar College may differ from course credit and units granted by a transfer institution.

Students may earn credit for Advanced Placement (AP) examinations with scores of 3, 4, or 5. AP credit may be used to meet AA GE and/or major course work, CSU GE, and IGETC requirements.

American History & Institutions (AH&I) Components: US-1: American History; US-2: U.S. Constitution & Government; US-3: California Government
Students who receive a minimum score of 3 on both the U.S. Government & Politics and U.S. History exams must also satisfactorily pass POSC 120 to fulfill the AH&I requirement.

AA: Advanced Placement exam credit is evaluated by corresponding it to an equivalent Palomar College course. A student who receives AP credit and who then takes the equivalent PC course will have the unit credit for such duplication deducted (usually from the exam) prior to being awarded an AA degree.

CSU/UC GE: All CSU and UC campuses will accept the minimum units shown and apply them toward fulfillment of the designated area if the examination is included as part of a full, partial, or subject-area certification. Each CSU/UC campus will determine how it will apply examinations toward credit in the major.

IGETC: Area 5, Physical & Biological Sciences, must have a minimum of 7 semester or 9 quarter units, with at least one course from Area 5A and one from 5B.
