How to find transfer information at California Public Colleges

I. **Articulated Majors** - (Not all majors are articulated)

- TO START ASSIST, double click on the ASSIST icon or type in <http://www.assist.org> in your internet browser
- Go to the EXPLORE TRANSFER INFORMATION page and select the school to which you would like to transfer (Example:CSU San Marcos)
- Select the academic year – usually the year you become a Palomar College student
- On the AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER CAMPUSES section, select Palomar College
- Select a Major

If you don't find your major listed, follow the directions for Course-to-course articulations

II. **Course-to-course Articulations**

- Look up the lower-division and major preparation requirements for your major
- Copy this information from the catalog or from the college web site. You may get this information on www.assist.org. When ASSIST has been started, click on RELATED SITES on the left side of your screen.
- Select either the CSU or UC System. When the screen opens, click on the school in which you are interested. You will then be able to search their catalog and find your major.

After you have the information you need for your lower division and major requirements, you are ready to find an equivalent course at Palomar College.

- From www.assist.org
- Go to the INSTITUTION AND ACADEMIC YEAR section on click on the drop-down window. Click on the school you are interested in
- Go to the AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER COLLEGES section. Click on the drop-down window and click on Palomar College
- Go to the BY DEPARTMENT section and choose ALL DEPARTMENTS for an alphabetical listing of all articulated courses entered on the ASSIST web site
- Look up each course needed for your lower-division general education and major requirements
