**Application for Graduation:** Upon enrollment in final requirements, submit a Petition for Graduation to the Evaluations Office in the Student Services Center, SSC-40. Petitions are available in the Counseling Center, at the Education Centers, in the Evaluations Office, and online. Students are strongly recommended to review graduation requirements with a counselor prior to applying; however, it is ultimately the student's responsibility to ensure completion of all requirements. **Catalog Rights:** The catalog used to determine eligibility for graduation will be the catalog in use at the time the student entered Palomar College and maintained continuous enrollment. A student may also elect to graduate under the catalog in use during the semester of application for graduation.

**Grade Point Average:** Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 ("C" average) or higher for all course work attempted. Some specific programs may require a higher GPA. Refer to the Palomar College catalog for specific information.

**Major:** Complete a specified major as outlined in the Palomar catalog. All course work within the major must be completed with a "C" grade or better. Please refer to the catalog or see a counselor for further information.

**Residency:** Complete a minimum of 12 units in residence as an officially enrolled student at Palomar College.

**Total Units:** Complete a minimum of 60 degree applicable semester units.

**Non-Degree Units:** Palomar College has designated courses numbered from 1 to 49 as non-degree applicable. These units will not count toward the 60 units required for an AA degree. Please refer to the catalog or see a counselor for specific information.

**Quarter Units:** Courses completed at a college or university on a quarter system must be a minimum of 4 quarter units in order to meet requirements here.
