

## ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY

### Students completing the CSU GE pattern and transferring to ASU should meet the following:

1. Choose from among ENG 202, ENG 203 or PHIL 115 to complete the A3 – Critical Thinking requirement. ASU will not accept the other choices to meet their second semester English composition requirement. Although the second semester composition is not an admission requirement, the student would be held to a second semester English course after transfer if they choose to complete A3 by using either PHIL 102, PHIL 120, Read 120, or SPCH 105.
2. Complete a lab component for both B1 – Physical Science and B2 – Biological Science. The second lab course is not an admissions requirement, however; the lab must be related to the lecture (e.g., a co-requisite). Therefore it is not recommended that the student try to pick up the second lab at ASU.
3. All grades on the CSU GE pattern should be a “C” or better.
4. All other areas on the CSU GE pattern should be completed as specified on the pattern.
5. Have Palomar College certify completion of the CSU GE pattern. That certification will not reflect completion of a second lab. ASU will confirm that from the student’s transcript.

The minimum admission GPA is 2.5. Some majors require at 3.00 for admission into that major (e.g., Business Administration, Engineering, Journalism, Biomedicine and Biomedical Informatics.). Merit scholarships are available for California residents with a 3.00 GPA.

### Students completing the IGETC pattern and transferring to ASU should meet the following:

1. Complete a lab component for both 5A – Physical Sciences and 5B – Biological Sciences. The second lab is not an admissions requirement; however, the lab must be related to the lecture (e.g., a co-requisite). Therefore it is not recommended that the second lab be taken at ASU.
2. All other areas on the IGETC should be completed as specifies on the pattern.
3. Have Palomar College certify completion of the IGETC pattern. That certification will not reflect the completion of a second lab course. ASU will confirm that from the student’s transcript.

The minimum admission GPA is 2.5. Some majors require at 3.00 for admission into that major (e.g., Business Administration, Engineering, Journalism, Biomedicine and Biomedical Informatics.). Merit scholarships are available for California residents with a 3.00 GPA.
