

This articulation was developed by Park University for transferring Palomar College courses to their institutions. If you are transferring Park University courses to Palomar you need to be aware of the following two issues:

EN 106 from Park College will **not** satisfy the Critical Thinking requirement (1B) on the IGETC as it does not contain the appropriate critical thinking components necessary for approval by the UC system. We will, however, use the course to satisfy the Critical Thinking (A3) requirement on the CSU GE pattern and the Communication and Analytical Thinking (A2) requirement on Palomar's AA pattern.

MA 131 from Park College has been equated by the Palomar college math faculty as being equivalent to our MATH 60 – intermediate algebra. It is considered to be a non-transferable, remedial math course and does **not** equate to our MATH 110 course. It would not be used to meet the math requirement on either the UC or CSU GE patterns. MA 131 could be used to meet the math competency requirement on our AA degree or any intermediate algebra major requirement at Palomar.
