Applicants for admission to the Los Angeles College of Chiropractic must have completed a minimum of 90 semester or 135 quarter units applicable to a bachelor's degree, with a cumulative G.P.A. of at least 2.50 on a 4.0 scale. All of the above courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. In each of the six distribution areas, if more than one course is taken to fulfill the requirement, the course contents must be unduplicated.
