

2009-2010 Palomar College and United States University Articulation Agreement: Lower Division General Education Requirements

Please note Community College students can transfer to United States University at any time as long as they have completed USU minimum enrollment/transfer requirements. USU's minimum requirement is a High School Diploma or equivalent.

Transfer Information: Students must have a High School diploma or GED or have passed the High School Equivalency exam. Transfer students can transfer up to 60 lower division units from Transfer Level Courses to USU under the following conditions: 1) Students must have a GPA of 2.0 in all transfer courses, AND 2) Each transfer course must be completed with a "C" grade or better.
*Please note United States university does not accept "D" grades.

Liberal Studies majors: see Lower Division Major and GE Requirements for Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies form instead.

B4: Technology (3 Units)	CSIT 105: Computer Concepts and Applications
Area C: Humanities <i>(Please complete 6 units to include 3 units from the Arts and 3 units from the Humanities)</i>	
C1: Arts (3 Units)	<i>Complete any C1 course from CSU Breadth General Education or any 3A course from IGETC</i>
C2: Humanities (3 Units)	PHIL 100: Philosophical Theories: Ethical & Political Values OR PHIL 101: Philosophical Theories: Knowledge & Reality
Area D: History and Social Science <i>(Please complete two courses from D1 and one course from D2).</i>	
D1: History (6 Units)	HIST 101: History of the US Through Reconstruction & HIST 102: History of the US Since Reconstruction OR AS 101: African American History I & AS 102: African American History II
D2: Social Science (3 Units)	PSYC 100: Introduction to Psychology
