

Westmont College

Students who wish to complete Westmont Colleges' GE pattern should pick a course for **each** area in Common Inquiries, A – H and Common Skills, A – D (see the Westmont College link). All courses must be completed with a “C” or better. It is not necessary that the student have a science lab course in either the physical or biological sciences areas. For major prep, contact Westmont College at <http://westmont.edu/> for an advisor to work with you in picking appropriate course work.

The maximum number of California community college courses that a student may transfer to Westmont College is 64 semester units. Students may transfer with as few units as they wish, however, if below 24 college semester units, high school admission requirements will apply. A High School Diploma is required, regardless of the number of units completed at the community college. The minimum admissions GPA is 2.00, however, the average community college transfer GPA for admissions is 3.00. Depending upon the major, a lower GPA might require that the student provide extra information and be interviewed for admission.
