

**AODS/PSYC/SOC 298**  
**Field Experience Worksheet – Due August 31, 2009**

**AODS/PSYC/SOC 298 course requires a minimum of 96 total lab hours during the semester.** This is an average of 6 hours per week for 15 weeks. Students are responsible for obtaining and maintaining a field experience internship in consultation with the instructor. It is the student's responsibility to secure an internship placement during the first four weeks of the semester and begin field placement work no later than September 14th.
