MINUTES

November 16, 2006

A meeting of the Palomar College Police Committee was held on November 16, 2006 at 3:30 p.m. in room SSC 35.

I. **Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order by Tom Plotts at 3:35 p.m.

II. **Review of Minutes**

III. **Unfinished Business**

a. Evaluation of Performing Arts permit procedures for 1 unit students. (Call for reevaluation from April 20 minutes)
It was reported that procedures were not being followed by the Performing Arts department. There was a question regarding need to continue this program or is impact too small. Request was made for total of other students taking only 1 unit. This was tabled to next meeting so Hawkins can take to Performing Arts and Brazeau to ASG for feedback.

- d. Report from meeting with Mike Ellis on request from Escondido for the addition of a crosswalk and stop sign.

- e. Report from Safety and Security regarding safety issues surrounding the Kiosk.
