Discussion ensued regarding the negative impact this issue ultimately has on Palomar College students. Cruz suggested this issue be brought to the ASG board. SanAgustin recommended an information sheet be developed for ASG representatives Loscher and Soto to bring to the December 3, 2008 ASG meeting. It was determined that SanAgustin would draft the information sheet and email it to all CPC members for input so that it would be ready for the 12/3 ASG meeting. SanAgustin recommended marketing ideas should the return to 24/7-365 enforcement be approved. Titus suggested Cruz inform the VPSS cabinet committee that the CPC is taking action on the year round enforcement issue.

b. Smoking issues on Campus (Loscher)

Loscher mentioned it had been brought to her attention that students were smoking in non-smoking designated areas. Discussion ensued regarding the difference between the Governing Board policy on smoking and the legal enforcement laws on smoking.
