**a. Committee Structure**

The change to committee structure was approved by SPC on 11/17. Therefore, Chief Cruz asked committee members if anyone was interested in serving as Chair for the Committee, adding that one person had already volunteered. As there were no further volunteers, the Committee was asked to vote on whether to appoint Dan Dryden as Chair for the remainder of the academic year. Asked why he volunteered to serve as the Chair, Mr. Dryden answered that he had done so out of "deep respect for the Police Department." MSC: Lambert/Titus (7-0).

**b. Quarterly Report (1<sup>st</sup> Quarter)**

Brian distributed the first-quarter report, describing the operations of the Police Department for the period July 1-September 30, 2009. The report included descriptions and statistics for the Police Department's performance in terms of Law Enforcement and Service Activities, Staffing, Special Projects, and Financial Status. Committee members recommended the department utilize the report to tie into the IRP and other planning processes. Additionally, they had input for 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter activities they felt could be included in the next report. The committee recommended forwarding of the report to SSPC as an informational item. #### **IV. Other**

##### **a. FRC item: NS-building cameras**

Sherry Titus asked Chief Cruz to brief the committee on the item brought to the Facilities Review Committee for cameras in the NS-building. He explained that there have been many reports of various types of "mischief", ranging from skateboarding around and inside the building to vandalism in the elevators. He shared that Dean Candi Francis had requested his input regarding how those activities could be limited or eliminated and that the faculty, staff, and administrators felt that cameras installed in the most public areas would make everyone feel much safer. He went on to explain that cameras sometimes invoke fears among the faculty regarding "big brother issues", despite the fact that they would not be utilized for anything other than criminal activity. Major concerns for the Police Department revolve around being able to fund necessary staff to monitor cameras, though the addition of cameras would mitigate the potential for dangerous and costly situations.
