**b. Visitor Parking (Cruz)**

Chief Cruz asked members of the committee for consideration of ways the Department could improve the facilitation of visitor parking. The current procedure leaves much to be desired, as there are a lot of visitors who park in the wrong place, or do not come to the Police Department office to receive a permit. Members discussed many different ideas to improve the process, but asked the staff of the Police Department to make some recommendations for them to examine and discuss at the next meeting.

**c. Revisit Revenue Initiative: Outside Entities (Cruz)**

Chief Cruz shared with the committee that some of the rejected revenue initiatives from the 2009/2010 year ran into difficulty primarily because some members of the Planning Council didn't really understand what we were asking for. One of these, he felt, was the item regarding fees for outside entities who rent district facilities to park on campus. Members felt that the student body would be very upset to find out that outside groups are receiving free parking privileges when students are paying for permits and sometimes are unable to find parking when they come to class. It was agreed to discuss this further at the next meeting.
