Spring 2009: January 15 to May 2—application deadline November 7, 2009
Summer 2009: June 5 to August 15—application deadline February 27, 2008
Fall 2009: August 27 to December 12—application deadline June 19, 2009

All applicants must:

1. Be authorized or eligible to work by law in the United States
2. Have completed their freshman year of college before the internship begins
3. Have a 3.0 GPA (preferred by some organizations)
