ALL OTHER SCHOOLS AND OUT OF DISTRICT 2012 GRADUATES WILL HAVE THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:

1. If it is a Palomar District alternative high school they could bring their students to a traditional high school in their district to be included in the testing there. Check with a district high school.
2. Students may come to the assessment center as a group and be tested. San Marcos has 33 computers and the Student Computer Lab could be requested and give us another 30. The Escondido Center has 16 computers. High school counselor needs to contact Palomar to schedule a testing appointment.
3. During the month of February and March we will be holding special assessments at the San Marcos and Escondido campuses for EAP students only. Calendar will be posted in January.
4. Students may go online, to the Assessment Website, mid March, to make an assessment appointment in San Marcos or Escondido for an April assessment. A full schedule of dates/times will be available. Class of 2012 students will need to tell the assessment proctor they are graduating seniors and will then receive EAP information.
