**GUARANTEE YOUR ADMISSION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, RIVERSIDE**  
**(UCR) THROUGH THE TAG PROGRAM (Transfer Admission Guarantee)**  
**FOR TRANSFER FALL 2010 AND WINTER 2011**

**What is the TAG?**

The TAG is an agreement between Palomar College and UCR, which guarantees upper division applicants' admission to the University in all majors.\* The UCR TAG allows transfers in fall and winter quarters.

**Who is eligible to participate in the TAG?**

- Once enrolled at the California Community College the student may contact UCR's Transfer Counselor to prepare a TAG contract before any classes are completed
- A student who is a U.S. citizen, permanent resident or AB540 qualified
- International students are also eligible to participate

**Who is NOT ELIGIBLE to participate in the TAG?**

- A student with coursework taken anywhere other than a California Community College
- A student who will not have attained the minimum 60 UC-transferable units including the two English composition courses, one math course and four courses in two of the following areas: arts and humanities, social and behavioral sciences, and biological and physical sciences courses necessary to satisfy regular UC admission requirements

**What are the requirements for the TAG?**

To transfer under the TAG agreement, you must fulfill the following:

- At the time of transfer to UCR, student must transfer with a minimum of 60 UC-transferable units, minimum GPA as determined by the major, and meet criteria as required by major\*
- Pass with a grade of "C" or higher the following subjects for minimum eligibility: two (2) UC-transferable English composition courses; one (1) UC-transferable math course; and four (4) UC-transferable courses chosen from at least two of the following areas: arts and humanities, social and behavioral sciences, and biological and physical sciences
- For fall 2010 transfers: apply November 1-30, 2009, minimum requirements may be completed in summer 2010
- For winter 2011 transfers: apply July 1-31, 2010, minimum requirements may be completed in fall 2010
- Maintain good academic standing (2.0 GPA or higher) during last full-time attendance before transfer

**How do I become a TAG participant?**

- Contact UCR at (951) 827-3824 and schedule an appointment to meet with a UC Riverside Transfer Counselor to discuss both your eligibility to the University and your eligibility to the TAG program and to receive course planning assistance

**Majors in the College of Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences** (other than Business Administration) **2.40 GPA**

**Business Administration** requires completion of all required courses necessary to satisfy selection criteria as outlined on [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) **2.50 GPA**
