

PALOMAR COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID DEADLINES, 2007-2008

- March 2, 2007** Deadline (postmark) to apply for the 1st round of **2007-2008 state Cal Grant A, B, or C**. The FAFSA must be submitted to the federal processor **and** G.P.A. either transmitted electronically by the school or the G.P.A. Verification Forms must always be submitted by the student to the California Student Aid Commission by March 2, unless that date falls on a Sunday or holiday. *See the Financial Aid Office to determine whether your G.P.A. can be electronically transmitted by the college.*
- September 4, 2007** Deadline (postmark) to apply for the 2nd round of **2007-2008 state Cal Grant A, B, or C**. The FAFSA must be submitted to the federal processor **and** G.P.A. either transmitted electronically by the school or the G.P.A. Verification Forms must always be submitted by the student to the California Student Aid Commission by September 2, unless that date falls on a Sunday or holiday. *See the Financial Aid Office to determine whether your G.P.A. can be electronically transmitted by the college.*
- October 13, 2007** Deadline for all federal financial aid applicants to finalize **Fall'07 class schedule activities**. This applies to all registration, adds and drops, to all types of classes: TV, on-line, semester length, short-term, late-start, accelerated, self-paced, etc. This date is the school's deadline for a "W" to appear on the student's record.
- October 26, 2007** Deadline to submit a **Financial Aid Petition (Satisfactory Academic Progress/Unit Limit)** to be effective for Fall'07 federal financial aid. Petitions submitted after this date will be considered for Spring'08 only.
- November 8, 2007** Deadline to submit an **Appeal to the Director** (for decisions on Fall 2007 petitions, overrides, special circumstances, etc.)
- November 16, 2007** Deadline for "Fall'07 only" AND "Fall'07 and Spring'08" **federal student loan applicants** to complete all loan processing requirements.
- November 16, 2007** Deadline to submit Fall'07 **Course Progress Status Certification** forms. After this date, no action will be taken until ALL Fall'07 grades are *officially posted*; Pell Grant will be the *only aid* considered for disbursement. If all grades meet a C/Cr minimum, the student should submit a Message Transmittal asking for retroactive Fall'07 Pell Grant based on successful completion of Fall'07 S.A.P. NOTE: all Pell Grant funds must be disbursed before the end of the award year.
- December 14, 2007** Deadline for "Fall'07 only" **Pell Grant applicants** to submit a final and valid 2007-2008 Student Aid Report and all required documentation to the Financial Aid Office.
- March 3, 2008** Deadline (postmark) to apply for the 1st round of **2008-2009 state Cal Grant A, B, or C**. The FAFSA must be submitted to the federal processor **and** G.P.A. either transmitted electronically by the school or the G.P.A. Verification Forms must always be submitted by the student to the California Student Aid Commission by March 2, unless that date falls on a Sunday or holiday. *See the Financial Aid Office to*

- March 15, 2008** Deadline for all federal financial aid applicants to finalize **Spring'08 class schedule activities**. This applies to all registration, adds and drops, to all types of classes: TV, on-line, semester length, short-term, late-start, accelerated, self-paced, etc. This date is the school's deadline for a "W" to appear on the student's record.
- April 4, 2008** Deadline to submit a **Financial Aid Petition (Satisfactory Academic Progress/Unit Limit)** to be effective for Spring'08 federal financial aid.
- April 4, 2008** Recommended deadline to mail 2007-2008 FAFSA to processor (to be considered for **Spring'08 Pell Grant**).
- April 11, 2008** Deadline to submit an **Appeal to the Director** (for decisions on Spring 2008 petitions, overrides, special circumstances, etc.)
- April 11, 2008** Deadline for "Spring'08" **federal student loan applicants** to complete all loan processing requirements.
- April 25, 2008** Deadline to submit Spring'08 **Course Progress Status Certification** forms. After this date, no action will be taken until ALL Spring'08 grades are *officially posted*; Pell Grant will be the *only aid* considered for disbursement. If all grades meet a C/Cr minimum, the student should submit a Message Transmittal asking for retroactive Spring'08 Pell Grant based on successful completion of Spring'08 S.A.P. NOTE: all Pell Grant funds must be disbursed before the end of the award year.
- May 2, 2008** Recommended deadline for applicants to submit all documentation requirements to Financial Aid Office (to be considered for **Spring'08 and/or Summer'08 Pell Grant**).
- May 23, 2008** Deadline for applicants to submit a final and valid 2007-2008 Student Aid Report to the Financial Aid Office (to be considered for **Spring'08 Pell Grant**).

GENERAL GUIDELINE FOR ALL TYPES OF AID: *apply early, submit documentation as quickly as possible, and continually monitor your status via Student e-Services and your Palomar student e-mail account! Crucial strategies in the financial aid process: Be Prompt, Be Complete, Be Consistent, and Stay In Touch.*

BOGW (enrollment fee waiver): recommended that students apply for AND receive approval PRIOR to registering for classes.

The annual Palomar all-in-one application for scholarships is generally due March 2. Some scholarship application deadlines may vary, depending on donor requirements. Check online regularly for news updates and announcements.
