

Prf Citizn—Proof of Citizenship

Proof of Citizenship - The Social Security Administration did not confirm your claim of U.S. citizenship because they questioned your social security number, name or date of birth. Submit a copy of your birth certificate, U.S. passport or naturalization papers.

Non2nd—Non -Citizen Secondary Confirm

Non-Citizen ID Secondary Confirmation - The Immigration and Naturalization Service did not confirm that you are an eligible non-citizen. A copy of your I-151, I-151C, I-551, or I-94 must be sent to INS directly to confirm that you are an eligible non-citizen.

ATB—Ability to Benefit Test

ATB Test - According to our records you are 18 years old or older and do not have a High School Diploma or GED. Since you do not have a diploma or GED, federal regulations make it mandatory that you take the assessment test. To take the assessment test contact the counseling office or, if you are an EOPS student, you may test through them.

Demo Data—Demo Data Mismatch

Name, Date of Birth, or Social Security Number Mismatch - The name, Date of Birth, or Social Security number you provided does not match with our data on file at Palomar College. Before you can be awarded financial aid we must resolve this conflict. Contact the Financial Aid Office to determine how to correct the error(s) and submit a copy of your Social Security card AND driver's license/I.D. or birth certificate.

SAR—Student Aid Report

Student Aid Report - You do not have a valid SAR on file the Financial Aid Office. Please review your SAR and resubmit it to the Federal Processor with all necessary changes. Your file will not be completed until we are in receipt of a valid SAR.

ISIR-Cor—ISIR Corrected

Information reported on your FAFSA has been changed. The federal processor will send a SAR-Acknowledgement that highlights these changes. A brief description of the changes made will be sent to your Student Email address.

BA Clarif—BA Degree Clarification

You reported that you either have a bachelor's degree by July 1, 2007 or that you will be a Graduate/Professional student in the 2007-2008 school year. In order to clarify this information you must complete the BA Clarification form at >< and return it to the Financial Aid Office.

Orphan/War--Orphan/Ward of Court Verification

Orphan or Ward of the Court Verification - You indicated on your aid application that you were a ward of the court until age 18 or an orphan. Please submit proof of this status.

SelService—Verify Selective Service Regis

Verify Selective Service Registration - The Selective Service could not confirm your registration or exemption status. You must contact the Selective Service at 847-688-6888 and resolve your status before you can receive financial aid.

SocSec—Untaxed Income-Social Security

Untaxed Income-Social Security - Your financial aid application shows that you received Social Security benefits in 2006. Submit proof (e.g., SSA-1099) of the total amount received for 2006.

SSCard—Copy of Social Security Card

Copy of Social Security Card - According to the Social Security Administration records, the name and Social Security number on your application do not correspond. Your name must match on your social security card, financial aid application, academic records and driver's license/state I.D. card. Contact the Financial Aid Office to determine how to correct the error(s) and submit a copy of your Social Security card and driver's license/I.D.

HS or GED--High School Diploma or GED

According to the Financial Aid documents you have submitted, it is unclear if you have a High School Diploma or your GED certification and when you received it.

Your file will not be processed until you have submitted either a copy of your High School Diploma or your GED certification to the Financial Aid Office.

Please be advised that in accordance with federal regulations, a student who is under 18 years of age must have a High School Diploma, GED or California Proficiency certification in order to be eligible for federal student aid.

Major--Major Declared in Admissions

To receive financial aid you must have a declared major listed with Admissions. Please consult the class schedule for a list of majors and submit your major to Admissions.

Note: acceptable majors include Associate of Arts, Transfer, some Certificates. Proficiency programs are not valid under federal aid regulations.

Marriage L--Marriage License

Please provide us with a copy of your marriage license.

2006 1040P—Signed Copy Parent 2006 Tax Return

Submit a *signed* copy of your Parents' 2006 1040 Federal Tax Return including W-2 forms and *all applicable schedules*

2006 P W-2--2006 Parent's W-2

Submit your Parents' W-2 Wage and Tax Statement(s) for the 2006 tax year even if they did file a 2006 1040 Federal Tax Form.

2006 1040S—Student's Signed 2006 1040

Submit a *signed* copy of your 2006 1040 Federal Tax Return including ALL W-2 forms and *all applicable schedules*.

2006 S W-2--2006 Student's W-2

Submit your 2006 W-2 Wage and Tax Statement(s) even if you did not or will not file a 1040 Federal Tax Form for 2006.

1040 Spous--Spouse's Signed 2006 1040

Submit a *signed* copy of your spouse's 2006 Federal Income Tax Return including W-2 forms and *all applicable schedules*.

06 Sp W-2--2006 Spouse's W-2

Submit your Spouse 2006 W-2 Wage and Tax Statement(s) even if you did not or will not file a 1040 Federal Tax Form for 2006.

Milt Allow--Military Living Allowance

Complete a message transmittal (http://www.palomar.edu/fa/07-08_PDF/2007_Message_Transmittal.pdf), listing the active duty military member's pay grade (example - E02), duty station zip code for 2006. Submit this to the Financial Aid Office.

Monthly leave and earning statements for 2006

DD214--DD214 Military Discharge

Submit a copy of your DD214 MEMBER COPY-4 as proof of Veteran status.

DL P Note--Direct Loan Promissory Note

SL-BNKRPT—Student Loan – Bankruptcy

Student Loan in Bankruptcy - According to your Student Aid Report you have a student loan that has been discharged in bankruptcy. You must provide documentation that this loan is dischargeable.

Loan Disch--Loan Discharge – Disability

Loan Discharged Due to Disability - For a borrower who had a disability cancellation to receive new loans, the borrower must have a doctor's certification that his or her condition has improved and sign a statement indicating that he or she is aware that the new loan cannot be canceled.

Def Loan--Defaulted Student Loan or Over

Your Student Aid Report indicated that you had a defaulted student loan or Financial Aid Overpayment. To clear the Defaulted student loan or to make payment arrangements contact the agency listed on your Student Aid Report.

To clear the Overpayment Status you must contact the school or agency listed on your Student Aid Report.

In order for you to awarded financial aid you must submit proof that your student loan is current and that you are eligible for financial aid. Your file will not be processed without documentation that your default or overpayment has been resolved.
