3. Applicant must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0.
4. Applicant must submit transcripts of college work and two (2) letters of reference.
5. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
6. If there are materials the applicant considers pertinent to the application, an extra page or pages may be included in the application packet.
