2009-2010 Scholarship Eligibility Reinstatement

In accordance with scholarship donors' and/or Palomar College requirements for continued eligibility for scholarship funds, the Financial Aid Office is required to review students' academic status and grades for each semester.

You have been determined to be ineligible or disqualified for the scholarship(s) you were awarded for the term specified in your official notification.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

To consider your Scholarship Eligibility Reinstatement request you must submit the completed form (*reverse side*) to the Financial Aid & Scholarships Office.

Explain why you were unable to complete all of your courses satisfactorily. Describe corrective or preventive actions taken to ensure that you will maintain satisfactory academic progress in the future.

Responses should be prepared thoughtfully and should focus on the reason(s) for the request. Students are reminded to meet the established submission deadlines. Any petition received after the semester deadline will be reviewed for consideration for the following semester.

SUBMISSION DEADLINES:

- Fall 2009 – November 13, 2009
- Spring 2010 – April 16, 2010

The decision regarding your reinstatement will be emailed to your Palomar College student email address within five (5) working days.
