

# PALOMAR COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID DEADLINES, 2010-2011

- March 2, 2010** Deadline (postmark) to apply for the 1<sup>st</sup> round of **2010-2011 California (CAL) Grant A, B, or C**. The FAFSA must be submitted to the federal processor **and** G.P.A. either transmitted electronically by the school or the G.P.A. Verification Forms must always be submitted by the student to the California Student Aid Commission by March 2, unless that date falls on a Sunday or holiday. Use WebGrants 4 Students to see if Palomar College electronically transmitted your GPA. Go to <https://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov/logon.asp> to create your access your account.
- September 2, 2010** Deadline (postmark) to apply for the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of **2010-2011 California (CAL) Grant A, B, or C**. The FAFSA must be submitted to the federal processor **and** G.P.A. either transmitted electronically by the school or the G.P.A. Verification Forms must always be submitted by the student to the California Student Aid Commission by September 2, unless that date falls on a Sunday or holiday. Use WebGrants 4 Students to see if Palomar College electronically transmitted your GPA. Go to <https://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov/logon.asp> to create your access your account.
- September 18, 2010**  
*end of 4<sup>th</sup> week (Saturday)* Deadline for all federal financial aid applicants to finalize **Fall 2010 class schedule activities**. This applies to all registration, adds and drops for all types of classes: TV, on-line, semester length, short-term, late-start, accelerated, self-paced, etc. This date is the school's deadline for a "W" to appear on the student's record.
- October 29, 2010**  
*end of 10<sup>th</sup> week (Friday)* Deadline to submit a **Financial Aid Petition (Satisfactory Academic Progress/Unit Limit)** to be effective for Fall 2010 federal financial aid. Petitions submitted after this date will be considered for Spring 2011 only.
- November 11, 2010**  
*end of 12<sup>th</sup> week (Thursday)* Deadline to submit Fall 2010 **Course Progress Status Certification** forms. After this date, no action will be taken until **all** Fall 2010 grades are *officially posted*. Pell Grant will be the *only aid* considered for disbursement. If all grades meet a C/Cr minimum, the student should submit a Message Transmittal asking for retroactive Fall 2010 Pell Grant based on successful completion of Fall 2010 Satisfactory Academic Progress. NOTE: all Pell Grant funds must be disbursed before the end of the award year.
- November 19, 2010** Deadline to submit an **Appeal to the Director** (for decisions on Fall 2010 petitions, overrides, special circumstances, etc.)
- November 24, 2010** Deadline for Fall 2010 **federal student loan applicants** to complete all loan processing requirements.
- December 17, 2010**  
*end of 17<sup>th</sup> week (Friday)* Deadline for "Fall 2010 only" **Pell Grant applicants** to submit a final and valid 2010-2011 Student Aid Report and all required documentation to the Financial Aid Office.
- February 12, 2011**  
*end of 4<sup>th</sup> week (Saturday)* Deadline for all federal financial aid applicants to finalize **Spring 2011 class schedule activities**. This applies to all registration, adds and drops, to all types of classes: TV, on-line, semester length, short-term, late-start, accelerated, self-paced, etc. This date is the school's deadline for a "W" to appear on the student's record.

- March 2, 2011** Deadline (postmark) to apply for the 1<sup>st</sup> round of **2011-2012 California (CAL) Grant A, B, or C**. The FAFSA must be submitted to the federal processor **and** G.P.A. either transmitted electronically by the school or the G.P.A. Verification Forms must always be submitted by the student to the California Student Aid Commission by March 2, unless that date falls on a Sunday or holiday. - April 1, 2011**  
*end of 10<sup>th</sup> week (Friday)* Deadline to submit a **Financial Aid Petition (Satisfactory Academic Progress/Unit Limit)** to be effective for Spring 2011 federal financial aid.
- April 4, 2011** Recommended deadline to mail 2011-2011 FAFSA to processor (to be considered for **Spring 2011 Pell Grant**).
- April 8, 2011** Deadline to submit an **Appeal to the Director** (for decisions on Spring 2011 petitions, overrides, special circumstances, etc.)
- April 15, 2011** Deadline for "Spring 2011" **federal student loan applicants** to complete all loan processing requirements.
- April 15, 2011**  
*end of 12<sup>th</sup> week (Thursday)* Deadline to submit Spring 2011 **Course Progress Status Certification** forms. After this date, no action will be taken until **all** Spring 2011 grades are *officially posted*. Pell Grant will be the *only aid* considered for disbursement. If all grades meet a C/Cr minimum, the student should submit a Message Transmittal asking for retroactive Spring 2011 Pell Grant based on successful completion of Spring 2011 Satisfactory Academic Progress. NOTE: all Pell Grant funds must be disbursed before the end of the award year.
- April 29, 2011** Recommended deadline for applicants to submit all documentation requirements to Financial Aid Office (to be considered for **Spring 2011 and/or Summer 2011 Pell Grant**).
- May 20, 2011**  
*end of 17<sup>th</sup> week (Friday)* Deadline for applicants to submit a final and valid 2010-2011 Student Aid Report to the Financial Aid Office (to be considered for **Spring 2011 and Summer 2011 Pell Grants**).

GENERAL GUIDELINE FOR ALL TYPES OF AID: *Apply early, submit documentation as quickly as possible, and monitor your status via Student e-Services and your Palomar student e-mail account regularly!* Crucial strategies in the financial aid process: Be prompt, be complete, be consistent, and stay in touch.

BOGW (enrollment fee waiver): recommended that students apply for **and** receive approval **prior** to registering for classes.

The annual Palomar all-in-one application for scholarships is generally due mid-February. Some scholarship application deadlines vary, depending on donor requirements. Check online regularly for news updates and announcements.
