1. Schedule classes in time patterns different from San Marcos to allow students/faculty to commute.
2. Uniform scheduling times will allow students to move from one class to another with less conflicts
3. Fast Track time blocks will be uniform with full-term classes, again allowing for students to move from one class to another
4. As much as possible, schedule sequenced classes for Fast Track I and II sessions
5. A number of classrooms will be designated for Fast Track sections only to ensure full utilization
6. Focus scheduling on Basic Skills and courses that satisfy IGETC requirements while still providing a variety of course options for students.
7. Schedule sequenced classes in a discipline or program to allow students to complete curriculum sequence from one semester to the next
8. Consider growth sections at Escondido to give students more options
