FACULTY SEMINAR GUIDELINES

Summer session start date: June 21, 2010. Class end date is the last seminar date, and no later than August 2 for the 6-week session and no later than August 16 for the 8-week session.

Faculty must provide the seminar dates for video classes. The following guidelines will help determine when video lessons are broadcast so that seminars can be appropriately scheduled.

- Schedule the first seminar the first week of the semester.
- Do NOT schedule a seminar on Monday, July 5, 2010.
- Schedule the last seminar using the guidelines listed below:
 - After July 28 for classes with 24-26 video lessons
 - After August 2 for classes with 30 video lessons
 - After August 12 for classes with 36 video lessons
 - After August 2 for classes with 36 video lessons with 6 lessons airing per week
- Video lessons are broadcast on holidays.
- The first week's lessons **will not** reair the second week.
- Typically, five lessons broadcast per week. (BIOL 101 is an exception with six lessons aired each week.)
