II. MINUTES OF October 29, 2008

MSC Estes, Dolan to approve the minutes of the October 29 Curriculum Committee meeting.

III. ACTION ITEMS

Ms. Brannick requested a motion to move the agenda to the report of the Information Competency/Computer Literacy Committee (CLIC). MSC Cater, Dolan

Ms. Jackie Martin-Klement began the report of the Information Competency/Computer Literacy Committee by introducing the members present. They included Judy Dolan, Terry Canon, and Katie French. Ms. Martin-Klement referred to the informational documents which were last distributed spring 2007 but have since been updated.

The committee clarified the meaning of Computer Literacy which refers to computer applications while Information Competency refers to critical thinking and accessing information. Although Computer Literacy is not yet identified as a basic skill at the state level, it is addressed as a part of Standard 2 of WASC Accreditation.

Although there are many on the market, the committee has identified three assessment tools from textbook publishers which are utilized on campus. McGraw Hill, Prentice Hall and Course Technology all offer assessments. Since all of the assessment tests are expensive, the committee is looking at several alternatives, one being to create our own test. The other alternative would be to cultivate a relationship with these publishers guaranteeing that the campus would use their textbooks.

Diane McCallister in Assessment has volunteered to administer the test as a part of the assessment process. The test would be used to counsel students into a class which would address any deficiencies identified by the assessment. Ms. Cuaron raised the concern that the Validation Instrument must be recognized by the System Office. The committee recognizes the need for the exam to be on the accepted list of assessments from the System Office. However, the System Office currently has no validated exam.

Terrie Canon presented examples of what other colleges are doing. Also, some of the exams were presented to the curriculum committee including examples of the types of questions which could be asked and the set up of each.

The CLIC committee will continue to research ways of implementing the assessment and bring their findings to the Curriculum Committee at future meetings.

2. Lower Division Transfer Pattern

Ms. Kerkhoff reported that before ASSIST, all approved courses were identified by a CAN or California Articulation Number, to facilitate transfer of courses. If a course could be proved by three institutions, it would be "CANNED." CAN is being replaced by the implementation of LDTP numbers, assigned by the CSUs. If course outlines do not match, they would either have to be changed or they would not receive an LDTP number. There has been much resistance but implementation is set to begin in Fall 2009. Ms. Kerkhoff will keep the committee updated as to any new developments.

3. Requisite Procedural and Page Changes

Ms. Cuaron presented a PowerPoint presentation of an idea for a new layout of requisites pages in Curricunet. Requisites and their supporting explanation and validation information would be addressed on individual pages. There was positive response from the committee and the consensus was to give Governet the go-ahead with building the process into Curricunet.

F. REPORTS

1. Academic Senate

Ms. Brannick reported on the meeting of the statewide Academic Senate which she attended. It was the 20 year anniversary of the passage of AB 1725. Resolutions passed were:

- A. Academic Senate opposes the usage of Student Learning Outcomes in Faculty evaluations.
- B. Academic Senate supports inclusion of a library of Student Learning Outcomes on their website. There were mixed feelings about this as many were concerned that the SLOs contained there would just be copied.
- C. Associate in Science (A.S.) and Associate in Arts (A.A.) Degrees were defined. A.S. degree would include courses in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics and Career, Technical and Extended Education). Degrees including all other types of courses would be considered A.A.

There is also a push to uniform drop deadlines and to provide better training for Accreditation teams.

2. Title 5, Chapter 6 Change Update

Continuing to make progress on necessary changes.

3. Multicultural Subcommittee

Ms. Payn reported a request for Multicultural approval was withdrawn for AIS 207A. A student petition was denied as there were none of the required components included.

4. Distance Learning Subcommittee

Mr. Estes reported Distance Learning approval for AIS 207A.

5. Information Competency/Computer Literacy

Report moved to beginning of agenda.

6. Academic Technology

Nothing to report although workgroups have been meeting.

7. Learning Outcomes/Basic Skills

Ms. Furch reported the completion of 237 Student Learning Outcomes to date. Workgroups are continuing to meet during the scheduled sessions.

The LOC Steering Committee is meeting regarding goals and activities for the year and developing subgroups. Judy Wilson has been appointed Service Learning Coordinator.

G. FUTURE ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

1. Transition of Lecture/Laboratory Courses

Transition of courses is continuing.

Ms. Brannick also requested that the committee consider making the Learning Outcomes Coordinator a voting member of the Curriculum Committee as the Curriculum Co-Chairs are in Learning Outcomes.

Ms. Kerkhoff announced that she had been notified of a letter a CSU employee received that the Board of Trustees could potentially declare the entire CSU System impacted.
