The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) is a pattern which will meet all lower-division general education requirements at all CSU or most UC campuses. Completion of the IGETC is not a requirement for transfer to CSU or UC, nor is it the only way to fulfill the lower-division GE requirements of the CSU or UC prior to transfer. Depending upon a student's major, it may be more advantageous to fulfill the CSU GE pattern requirements, or those of the UC campus or college to which the student plans to transfer. Some colleges within the UC system will not accept IGETC.

**IGETC Pattern Rules:**

- Upon enrollment in final requirements, the student should apply for transfer certification by submitting a Petition for Graduation/Transfer Certification, along with this Advising Guide signed by a Counselor, to the Evaluations Office.
- Complete all IGETC courses with a "C" grade or better; a "C-" grade is not acceptable
- UC transfers need not complete the Oral Communication requirement (Area 1, Group C)
- CSU transfers need not complete the Language Other Than English (Area 6) requirement. It is recommended that CSU transfers complete the U.S. History, Constitution, and American Ideals requirement prior to transfer.
- Some UC transferable courses have credit limitations. Specific limitations are indicated with the course descriptions in the Catalog or may be found on the assist website at <http://www.assist.org>.
- **UC System IGETC Information:** Some UC campuses may not allow use of the IGETC for students who were previously enrolled at a UC campus. If selecting a high-unit major such as Engineering or the sciences, students should focus on lower-division major prep course work and on completing the UC minimum eligibility general education requirements. Please see the Transfer Center for details.
- **UC Campus-Specific IGETC Information:** The IGETC is not appropriate for students selecting the following majors:

- **NOTE:** Many majors in the College of Letters and Sciences at UC Davis do not accept the IGETC
- **NOTE:** UC San Diego Eleanor Roosevelt and Revelle Colleges do not accept the IGETC
- Palomar may certify course work completed at California Community Colleges provided it appears on their IGETC course list. Course work completed at other colleges and universities may be included with approval from our faculty and the Evaluations Office. CLEP credit or foreign course work will not be included on the IGETC certification.
- Advanced Placement (AP) exams may be used to satisfy most areas of IGETC with the exception of Areas 1B and 1C. AP exams with a minimum score of 3 may be used provided they equate to an approved IGETC course. Credit may be awarded for only one course per area.
- The IGETC program began in Fall 1991. Course work completed prior to that semester may be used if it appeared on the 1991-92 IGETC course list. All courses taken in Fall 1992 or later may be used according to the approval dates as noted (FXX).
