

## Did You Know...

### Roughly how many of Palomar's Fall'08 Credit Students were from "Low-Income" San Diego County Households?

Palomar's Research Office identified all students who received a grade of A/B/C/CR/D/F/FW/NC/W in a Fall'08 Credit course. Regional Occupational Program and Apprenticeship courses (except AP WE) were excluded from the analysis.

Of the 24,809 Credit students identified, 89.4% (22,176) were from San Diego County Zip codes.

20,533 (82.8%) were from San Diego Zip codes for which 2000 Census poverty level figures are available from SANDAG<sup>†</sup>.

"Low-Income" is defined as being at 150% of poverty level or below. (SANDAG data are for 149% of poverty level or below.)

**Analysis of SANDAG data indicates that almost 1 of every 5 (18.9%) of those students was from a Low-Income household.**
