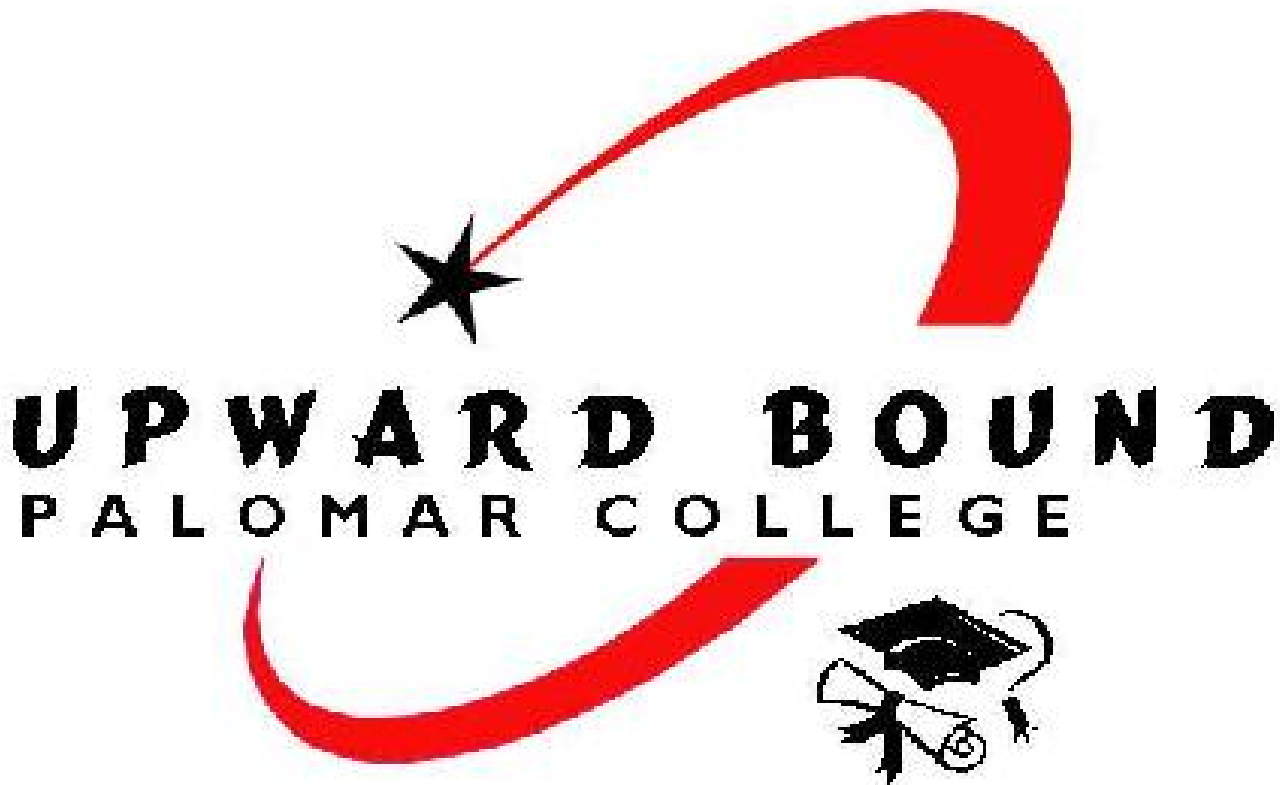

From the west: East on Route 78 to Broadway (Lincoln and Broadway). Do not turn onto Broadway, but continue east on Lincoln to Midway Drive (4 way stop sign intersection). Turn right (south) onto Midway and proceed to East Valley Parkway. The campus is at the intersection of Midway and E. Valley Parkway across the intersection on the right hand side.

From the north: Proceed south on I – 15 to El Norte Parkway, proceed east on El Norte Parkway to Midway Drive. Turn right (south) onto Midway and proceed as above.

From the south: Proceed north on I – 15 to Route 78 East/Ramona exit. Route 78 becomes Lincoln Avenue after it crosses Broadway. Continue on Lincoln to Midway Drive (4 way stop sign intersection). Turn right onto Midway and proceed as above.
