



CALIFORNIA MOTORCYCLE TRAINING 5 – HOUR *Experienced RiderCourse*

We have received your registration fee for the California Motorcycle Training *Experienced RiderCourse*. This course is designed to refine your current mental and physical riding skills (This **is not** the DMV recognized course.)

Training is designed for motorcyclists with a motorcycle endorsement on their license. Our advanced course includes 5 hours of on-cycle instruction where you will deal with the mental strategies for riding in traffic, understanding correct riding techniques, and motorcycle handling characteristics. We will also focus on the physical skills of advanced braking, cornering, swerving, and controlling rear-wheel skids.

Please be on time for your sessions. You must attend all portions of the course to continue, and successfully complete it. There are no refunds or transfers one full week prior to your class start date. **Cancellations are subject to a \$15 processing fee.**

You will need to bring with you: Long, straight-legged pants (jeans minimum), long sleeved shirt or jacket, boots that cover your ankles, full-fingered leather gloves, eye protection and a DOT approved helmet. Remember to dress for the weather. Class goes on RAIN OR SHINE. **Don't forget your Motorcycle!** You may also want to bring water and a snack.

Your bike will be given a basic safety inspection prior to riding. So, be sure it is in good running, mechanical order with good tires. Make sure you fuel up before the riding session. Sorry, we cannot accept "chopped" three-wheeled or extremely modified motorcycles. **Also NO AFTER-MARKET PIPES ALLOWED on our range . Please respect our neighbors and keep your noise level at a minimum when arriving on campus.**

You will also need to show a valid class (M) motorcycle license. Your motorcycle registration and proof of insurance are also required.
