

**Material List for Acrylic Class**

1. Palette. You may use any plastic tray with lid, or cover with foil. Or an acrylic palette. You can even use two plastic picnic plates.
2. Palette/painting knives, you will need two. One large, and one small. Plastic ones are ok.
3. Brushes. One acrylic brush, size, 6 or 8 round, and one size. 6 or 8 flat.
4. Spray bottle. It should have a mist setting.
5. Water container. No glass. Plastic such as a cottage cheese container, butter, etc.
6. Support to paint on. Two canvas boards, or stretched canvas 8x10, and two 9x12.
7. Paper towels, and rags for clean up, and wiping brushes.
8. Containers. Small. Such as baby food jars, film canisters, Or you can purchase a set of twelve small containers with air tight lids at the dollar stores, or Michaels, etc. Anything plastic with air tight lids. If you wish to use the mediums as well, you will need 3 extra containers.
9. Apron, or old shirt, etc, To protect clothes.
10. Plastic tablecloth or etc. to cover table.
