Welcome, and thank you for joining the class! I want to help you get some of those clothes that have been hanging in your closet back into wearable condition. You will learn to how to do both hand and machine-sewn hems, simple alterations and minor repairs to get your clothes back into service. Please bring the following items to class:

- scissors 7”– 10” and small clipping scissors
- pins and pin cushion or magnet holder.
- marking pencil disappearing or water base, and/ or chalk wheel.
- tape measure and seam gauge or 6 inch clear ruler
- thread to match the color of the garments to be repaired.
- universal needles mixed package 70,80,90
- denim needle if you are repairing heavy fabrics, i.e. jeans
- fabrics that you may wish to use in the repair of your garment such as a lining replacement for pockets, etc.

Six to eight items for repair. These may include, skirts, dresses, blouses, pants, jackets, etc. Maybe there are other people in the family who need items repaired, so feel free to bring garments that not “yours”. Please email me if you have any questions you would like answered before the class starts. See you June 18th!
