Description of Community Services Classes

- A. **Community Services Class.** A Community Services class is a class which meets the following minimum requirements:
1. Is approved by the local district governing board.
 2. Is designed for the physical, mental, moral, economic, or civic development of persons enrolled therein.
 3. Provides subject matter content, resource materials, and teaching methods which the district governing board deems appropriate for the enrolled students.
 4. Is open to all members of the community.
 5. Must be self-supporting.
