Adding in Summer grades increases the overall success rates and would require resetting the institution-set standards and stretch goals for which the college has already reviewed and discussed this year. For this report, and per email confirmation with ACCJC, we have opted to report fall course completion rates. We will revisit setting our methodology, standards, and stretch goals during our planning process next year.</b></p> <p><b>Question #14 Degrees and Certificates.
