John Paul the Great Catholic University and Palomar Community College District Articulation Agreement

Effective period: September 28, 2016 — September 6, 2019

This articulation agreement lists courses which transfer to John Paul the Great Catholic University (“JPCatholic”) from Palomar Community College District and indicates which ones fulfill specific requirements. Courses not listed in this agreement may be appropriate for transfer in some instances. There are 4 parts:

Part I: Courses which fulfill general education requirements.

Part II: Courses which are equivalent to major-specific courses.

Part III: Courses which qualify as electives.
