The attached document summarizes SF State curriculum changes effective Spring, Summer or Fall 2017.

Impaction update

Effective Fall 2018, SF State will no longer be impacted as a campus. Students applying for the Fall 2018 term will be held to regular CSU transfer eligibility criteria, unless applying to an impacted program for which additional criteria may apply.

Effective Fall 2018, the Interior Design major will no longer be impacted. Students applying to this major for the Fall 2018 term will be held to regular CSU transfer eligibility criteria.

Substantive program revisions

The Communication Studies B.A. has a new lower division requirement effective Fall 2017. [More information here.](#) SF State courses satisfying this requirement align with current C-ID descriptors, and articulation will be processed for courses approved for these descriptors. See attached list of curriculum changes for details.

Advanced Placement credit for courses

Course equivalency has been determined for an expanded number of AP exams taken 2016 and after. Please consult <http://bulletin.sfsu.edu/undergraduate-education/standardized-external-examinations/> for more information.

Associate Degrees for Transfer

The most updated list of formally approved "similar" ADT pathways to SF State degree programs is posted at <http://ueap.sfsu.edu/articulation/roadmaps>. While the B.A. or B.S. degrees associated with the ADTs below can be completed in 60 units after transfer, certain lower division courses required for the SF State degree may not be part of the ADT's core requirements. Completion of these courses before transfer will support progress in the major after transfer.

- AS-T Biology – all concentrations in Biology require a semester of organic chemistry.
- AS-T Business Administration – at this time, the only formal pathway from this ADT is the General Business concentration of the B.S. in Business Administration. Calculus and statistics are required for the SF State degree.
- AS-T Computer Science – ideally, students will take a human biology or microbiology course before transfer – see B.S. Computer Science in ASSIST. Also, lower division foundation courses for the SF State degree are taught using JAVA. Our department limits new one-to-one articulation to comparable courses based on JAVA. (Students with the ADT or who have taken articulated courses without JAVA do not need to retake these courses.)
- AS-T Early Childhood Education – the CAD B.A., which is impacted, requires a second semester of written English composition among the supplemental criteria for admission into all concentrations
- AS-T Film, Television, Electronic Media – all lower division requirements for B.A. Cinema and B.A. BECA can be met via the AS-T depending on the requirements included in the local degree and choices made by students.
- AS-T Geology – one semester of physics (either algebra or calculus-based) is required for the Earth Sciences B.A. and B.S.
- AS-T Kinesiology – human biology with lab (or one semester of general biology for majors) and statistics, are prerequisites for the major.
- AS-T Physics – a lower division course in differential equations and linear algebra is a prerequisite for key courses in the upper division.

A second semester/quarter of written English composition is an undergraduate graduation requirement at SF State and is a prerequisite for an upper division writing-intensive course required in all degree programs at SF State. Completing this additional lower division writing course before transfer will support progress in the major after transfer.
