# CURRICULUM UPDATES CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, SACRAMENTO 2017-18 CATALOG

# **BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION:**

Business no longer requires Operating Systems as part of their Computer Literacy requirement MIS 1 is now Word Processing, MIS 2 is still Spreadsheets and MIS 3 is now Presentation Graphics. Courses currently articulated for Word Processing, Spreadsheets and Presentation Graphics will stand.

### **CHILD DEVELOPMENT:**

CHDV 35F is only required in the Integrated Pre-Credential and Elementary Pre-Credential Concentrations.

# **COMMUNICATION SCIENCES AND DISORDERS:**

Department name change from Speech Pathology.

### **COMMUNICATION STUDIES:**

Concentration in Digital Media is no longer being offered.

### EARTH SCIENCE:

<u>GEOL 17</u> - Earth Materials has been removed from lower division major preparation listed on the agreement and this course no longer offered.

### **ECONOMICS:**

Freshman or transfer students interested in the Economics Major are admitted as Pre-Major Economics students. In order to declare the ECON major students must:

- 1. Have an overall GPA of 2.0 and be in good academic standing.
- 2. Complete the Pre-Major Required Courses ECON 1A, ECON 1B, MATH 24 and STAT 1 with a "C" or better in each course (Only first or second attempts will be considered).

<u>Math 24 - Modern Business Math</u> was added to Lower division major pre-requisites. ECON will accept <u>Math 26A - Calculus I for the Social and Life Sciences or Math 30 - Calculus I in lieu of</u> <u>MATH 24</u>.

### **ENVIROMENTAL STUDIES:**

<u>BIO 10 - Biological Concepts and BIO 15L Lab - Investigations in Biology</u> will be accepted in Lieu of <u>BIO 2 - Cells, Molecules and Genes</u>. Articulation agreement will indicate students have the option of completing BIO 2 <u>or</u> BIO 10 <u>and</u> 15L.

### FAMILY AND CONSUMER SCIENCE:

The Single Subject Matter Program (Pre-Credential Prep) and the Family & Consumer Science Education concentrations are now Family & Consumer Science Education (Pre-Credential Single Subject Program). The Dietetics Special Major Program is now an Emphasis in Dietetics under the Family and Consumer Science major.

The Fashion Merchandising and Design students now have the option of completing FACS 10 <u>or</u> FACS 50 as part of their lower division major preparation.

# **GEOLOGY:**

Correction to required Math course for the B.A. - Pre-Calculus will be removed. MATH 26A CALCULUS for SOC+LIFE SCI or MATH 30 CALCULUS I is required.

# **GRAPHIC DESIGN:**

Under "IMPORTANT NOTICE" section at the top of the agreement, "Before being admitted into the upper division program, the student must complete with a minimum "C" grade or better:" GPDH 5, GPHD 10, GPHD 20, GPHD 25, GPHD 30, ART 20A and PHOT 40.

# **HUMANITIES & RELIGIOUS STUDIES:**

Students pursuing the Religious Studies Concentration may select 3 of the required lower division courses listed. The Humanities Concentration still requires students to complete all 4 courses (HRS 10, HRS 11, HRS 70 and HRS 71).

# **KINESIOLOGY:**

The Exercise Science Concentration has renamed both of their options within the concentration. The Exercise Science option is now <u>Health Fitness/Strength Conditioning</u> <u>Specialist Option</u> and the Therapeutic Exercise and Rehabilitation option is now <u>Clinical Exercise</u> & <u>Rehabilitation Specialist Option</u>. In addition to the lower division major pre-requisites, both options require an additional 13 elective units. Lower division options for completing these electives are listed on the articulation agreement. <u>PHYS 5A and STAT 1</u> have been moved from the required lower division pre-requisite course list to the 13 unit elective list on the agreement.

B.S. Degree in Athletic Training - Required lower division added BIO 25, BIO 26. Deleted BIO 10, 22, CHEM 1 or 6A, CHEM 1B or 6B.

# MUSIC:

B.A. deleted MUSC 10B and 14C, added MUSC 10A <u>or</u> 10C. For the B.M. deleted MUSC 14D, added MUSC 1C. For the concentration in Jazz Studies added MUSC 14D, 50 and MUS 118B.

# **NURSING:**

Effective fall 2016 an approved AREA B4 STATISTICS course is required. If the Statistics course is approved for CSU GE Area B4, Nursing will accept it (this includes courses taught in departments other than MATH or STAT).

Note: 2017-18 agreements top portion of the agreement will not be as text heavy, links to information will be provided.

# **PSYCHOLOGY:**

Psychology no longer requires PSYC 2 to be completed within 2 attempts and will allow a 3<sup>rd</sup> attempt.

# SOCIAL WORK:

Freshman or transfer students interested in the Social Work Major are admitted as a Pre-Major. In addition to the required lower division SWRK 95 students must complete 3 courses (9 units) in CSU GE Areas B2 and D with a minimum "C" grade. The required pre-major courses have been added to the articulation agreement.

AREA B2 Life Forms select ONE: BIO 1, BIO 10, BIO 20 or ANTH 1 AREA D Individual and Society (Part A) select ONE: ECON 1A, ECON 1B, PSYC 2 or SOC 1 AREA D Individual and Society (Part B) select ONE: CRJ 1, SOC 3 or SOC 10

It is strongly recommended for pre-major course work to be completed prior to transfer.

### **SPEECH PATHOLOGY & AUDIOLOGY:**

Major name change. New name is **<u>Communication Sciences and Disorders</u>**.

# THEATRE AND DANCE:

Added THEA 14 Stage Makeup and Costume Construction to lower division major preparation.

# **WORLD LANGUAGES & LITERATURES:**

Department name change. Foreign Languages department is now **World Languages &** Literatures.
