Dear Counselors,

As the UC transfer application deadline approaches, I want to share with you important information regarding the admissions process for the Undergraduate Program in Urban Studies. I hope you find this letter helpful and ask that you pass the information along to any of your students interested in applying to the Urban Studies major at UC Berkeley.

To ensure that the lower division requirements reflect the interdisciplinary upper-division curriculum, the Urban Studies faculty implemented two significant changes in the Fall 2017:

- 1) Beginning Fall 2017 Calculus is no longer required for the Urban Studies major.
 - a. Note that while not required, calculus will provide students with opportunities to deepen their knowledge and skill set in preparation for advanced study in a graduate City and Regional Planning program.
- 2) The list of lower division major electives has been expanded.
 - a. Attached to this letter is a list of UC Berkeley courses that fulfill the requirement. Since assist.org was not updated this year, your student should look at the articulation for these courses by department on assist.org.
