#### **COLLEGE OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS**

**ACCOUNTANCY, B.S.** - Replace COMP 100 (Computers: Their Impact and Use) with IS 212\* (Information Systems for Business Users).

**BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION, B.S.** - Replace COMP 100 (Computers: Their Impact and Use) with IS 212\* (Information Systems for Business Users).

**ECONOMICS, B.A.** – Add IS 212\* (Information Systems for Business Users) to Lower Division Major Preparation Courses.

**FINANCE, B.S.** - Replace COMP 100 (Computers: Their Impact and Use) with IS 212\* (Information Systems for Business Users).

**INFORMATION SYSTEMS, B.S.** – Change Lower Division Major Preparation Courses- now the same as the other College of Business and Economics B.S. degrees:

Add IS 212\* (Information Systems for Business Users)

Math requirement in both options: MATH 103 or MATH 150A or MATH 255A

PHIL 230 (Formal Logic) – No longer required in Business Systems option; still required in Information Technology option

**MANAGEMENT, B.S. -** Replace COMP 100 (Computers: Their Impact and Use) with IS 212\* (Information Systems for Business Users).

**MARKETING, B.S.** - Replace COMP 100 (Computers: Their Impact and Use) with IS 212\* (Information Systems for Business Users).

\*Either C-ID BUS 140 or C-ID ITIS 120 accepted for IS 212. Courses articulated to COMP 100 are accepted to satisfy this requirement if completed through Summer 2019 for all majors above.

**CENTRAL AMERICAN STUDIES, B.A.** – Changes in lower division electives

**CINEMA AND TELEVISION ARTS, B.A.** – Option in Electronic Media Management. Title changed to: Entertainment Media Management.

**CRIMINOLOGY AND JUSTICE STUDIES, B.A.** – **New ADT Match** - Deemed "similar" to AA-T in Law, Public Policy and Society

Major requirement was added under the Sociology agreement. I am unable to add a new major heading on ASSIST Legacy.

**GEOGRAPHY, B.A.** – **New ADT Match:** Both options deemed "similar" to AS-T in Environmental Science

**GEOLOGY, B.S. - New ADT Match:** General Geology option deemed "similar" to AS-T in Environmental Science

**KINESIOLOGY, B.S.** – Physical Education Option – Deleted Movement course requirement (3 units Dance, Fitness, Sport) from Lower Division Major Preparation. Students are already required to take KIN 130A-133A, 151 (1), KIN 242 (1), KIN 250SW (1) for the option. (Fall 2018 implementation. This was also reported in the 2017-18 Curricular Summary)

**KINESIOLOGY, B.S.** – Sport Studies Option – **New ADT Match:** Changes in upper division requirements allow the option to be deemed "similar" to the AA-T in Kinesiology.

**NURSING, B.S. – SECOND BACHELOR'S ACCELERATED DEGREE** – No longer available as of Fall 2018. Beginning Spring 2019 the A-BSN program will be administered through CSUN's Tseng College.

**POLITICAL SCIENCE, B.A.** – **New ADT Match:** All three options deemed "similar" to AA-T in Law, Public Policy and Society

**PUBLIC HEALTH, B.S.** – Removed BIOL 211/212 (Human Anatomy/Lab) from Lower Division Major Preparation requirements.

**SOCIOLOGY, B.A.** – Removed SOC 202 (Sociological Analysis) from Lower Division Major Preparation requirements.
