Zero Textbook Cost (ZTC) courses

This means the course either:

- Does not have a textbook
- → Has a textbook, which is available for FREE!

ZTC courses may have a printed option available in the bookstore and may still have a material fee. Some ZTC courses may also have a publisher textbook you can purchase as another choice, but ZTC courses are required to provide at least one free option. Students must be able to be successful in the class if choosing the ZTC option.



Low Textbook Cost (LTC) Courses

This means the total cost for textbooks for this course is under \$40.

LTC may include the choice of a textbook under \$40 or a more expensive option. Students must be able to be successful in the class if choosing the LTC option. NOTE: your course may still have a materials fee, even if it is a Low Textbook Cost course.

What is OER, ZTC, and CALM?

*Comets Affordable Learning Materials

CALM = Comets Affordable Learning Materials

OER = Open Educational Resources

The term 'Open Educational Resources' (OER) describes any educational resources (including curriculum maps, course materials, textbooks, videos, multimedia applications, podcasts, or any other materials designed for teaching and learning) which have been made available for use under open licenses – which means that anyone can use, adapt and redistribute them. Those materials may be available online, in print, on DVD or any other medium. --from Open Educational Resources Policy in Europe ZTC = Zero Textbook Costs

Senate Bill 1359 (Block, 2016) requires California Community Colleges and California State Universities and requests the University of California system to include a symbol/logo in the online campus course schedule by January 1, 2018

Z-Degrees are degrees or certificates that can be completed without any textbook costs for students.These might use OER, library materials, or other no-fee solutions.
