Zero Textbook Cost (ZTC) To be a ZTC labeled course, there must be no associated textbook costs. In other words, students must be able to access any required textbook material completely free of charge.



Low-Cost Textbooks (LTC) To be designated as a low cost course, the total price for all required textbooks must be \$40 or less. This must be the price available to students through the campus bookstore. It is important that this pricing is for the textbooks from the bookstore, as students receiving financial aid are often only eligible to use that aid through our campus bookstore.

Since the introduction of Palomar College's CALM program, students have saved an estimated \$10,630,860 in total textbook costs. Students saved an estimated \$799,740 this semester alone!
