# PALOMAR COLLEGE CAMP PENDLETON

## STEPS TO ENROLL

### 1. Apply Online

Apply online at [www.palomar.edu/apply](http://www.palomar.edu/apply). You will receive your Palomar Student ID number in two - three business days.

Set up your student email and download the Palomar College Mobile app to add/drop classes, pay fees, and find your textbooks.



### 2. Residency & Priority Registration Verification

- Deemed “Non-Resident” during admission process? Active Duty and military dependents are exempt from non-resident tuition. Contact the Admissions Office to find out how to change your residency status to receive in-state tuition rate. Note: to be eligible for state financial aid including the California College Promise Grant (CCPG) tuition waiver, students must have in-state residency status.

- Priority Registration is available for Active Duty Military and Veteran Students. To activate your eligibility please contact our Camp Pendleton Education Center.



### 3. Complete New Student Orientation

Orientation is mandatory for new students. Visit [www.palomar.edu/orientation](http://www.palomar.edu/orientation) to complete your orientation online.



### 4. Counseling Appointments

- Request your official Joint Service Transcript and official transcripts from all of the colleges you have attended.
- Make an in-person or virtual academic advising appointment through the Counseling Office at (760) 891-7511.



### 5. Apply for Financial Aid or Tuition Assistance

- FAFSA: State Aid (California Promise Grant) and Federal Aid is available to those who qualify. Apply today at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) and use our School Code: 001260

- Tuition Assistance (TA): First time users should speak with the Base Education Center before enrolling into classes. Once you have enrolled into classes, please let us know you are using TA to prevent being dropped from class. If your TA is not approved, you will be responsible for paying for your class or finding another method of payment (i.e.FAFSA).



### 6. Register for Classes

You may enroll into any classes at the time of your registration appointment or after. Classes are first-come, first-served and will fill up quickly. Enroll as soon as possible!



### 7. Pay Enrollment Fees

Fees can be paid online through your MyPalomar account.

You must pay for classes within 10 calendar days of registration to avoid being dropped from your classes. If you are using TA or VA Education Benefits, please let us know to avoid being dropped from classes and paying out of pocket.



### 8. Textbooks

- Textbooks can be purchased by visiting the Palomar Bookstore at [www.palomar.edu/bookstore](http://www.palomar.edu/bookstore)
- Free pick-up option for the Camp Pendleton Center is available by emailing the bookstore with your order number and requesting Camp Pendleton as your pickup location.

- Reserve textbooks are available at the Patrick J. Carney Library on Mainside
