The top three faculty positions were added to the top of the original list of 20 faculty recommendations made in spring 2019 per the following recommendation by the IPC Faculty Prioritization subcommittee on 10/9/19:

*“MSC (Dr. Barb Kelber/Dr. Ellen Weller): Given that there were four failed searches in the Fall 2019-2020 hiring process, and one of the four (Business) has gone out to fill their position, the remaining three failed searches will move to the top of the Fall 2020-2021 faculty prioritization list in their original ranked order: Psychology, Biology, and Child Development. If there are no faculty hires for Fall 2020, this matter will be revisited.”*

Business was added back into the top position in November 2019 after a failed search.
