"I want to work in a preschool"

Path: Associate Teacher Certificate

- Start with: CHDV 100 and CHDV 115
- Earn your Associate Teacher Certificate with 12 units
- Tip: Volunteer/work in a preschool while taking classes

"I want to work full time as a preschool teacher"

Path: Teacher AS Degree

- Start with the Associate Teacher Certificate
- Continue with general education + practicum courses



"I love children, but don't want to be a teacher"

Path: Child & Adolescent Dev. AS-TCareers that support children &

- families in broader ways
- Start with the Ass. Teacher Cert.
- Transfer path to earn BA
- Path: Children & Family Services AS
 - Careers related to social work, counseling, and nonprofit organizations
- Start with the Ass. Teacher Cert.
- Transfer & explore BA & MS options



"I want to teach TK-3rd Grade"

Path: Child & Adolescent Development AS-T

- Start with the Associate Teacher Certificate
- Transfer to earn BA in Child & Adolescent Development (Not Liberal Studies!)
- Continue your education to earn the new PK-3 credential

"I have a BA, but not in Child Development"



Path: Teacher AS Degree

- Take 24 units in CHDV
- Apply to a Teacher Credentialling Program (TK-8th grade)



"I want to teach 4th-6th Grade"

Path: University Studies Elementary Education Preparation AA

- University Studies Elementary Education Preparation AA Degree (for Transfer)
- Transfer to earn BA in Liberal Studies or Elementary Education
- Continue your education to earn a Multiple Subject Teaching Credential



"I don't know what I want yet"

Path: Start with Associate Teacher Certificate

- Take the core classes for the Associate Teacher Certificate (CHDV 100 & 115)
 - Discover interests & meet with a Child Development professor for guidance
