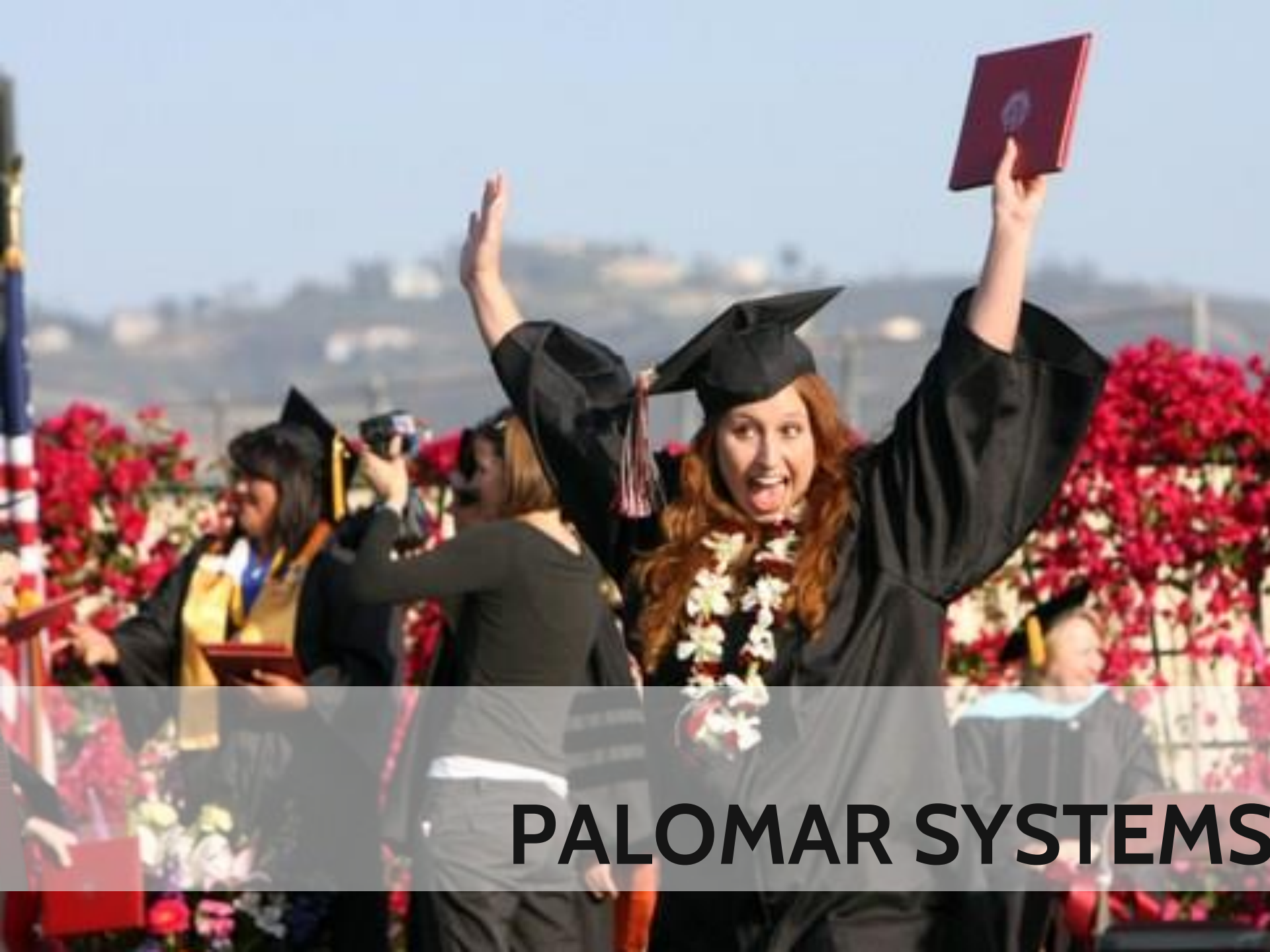

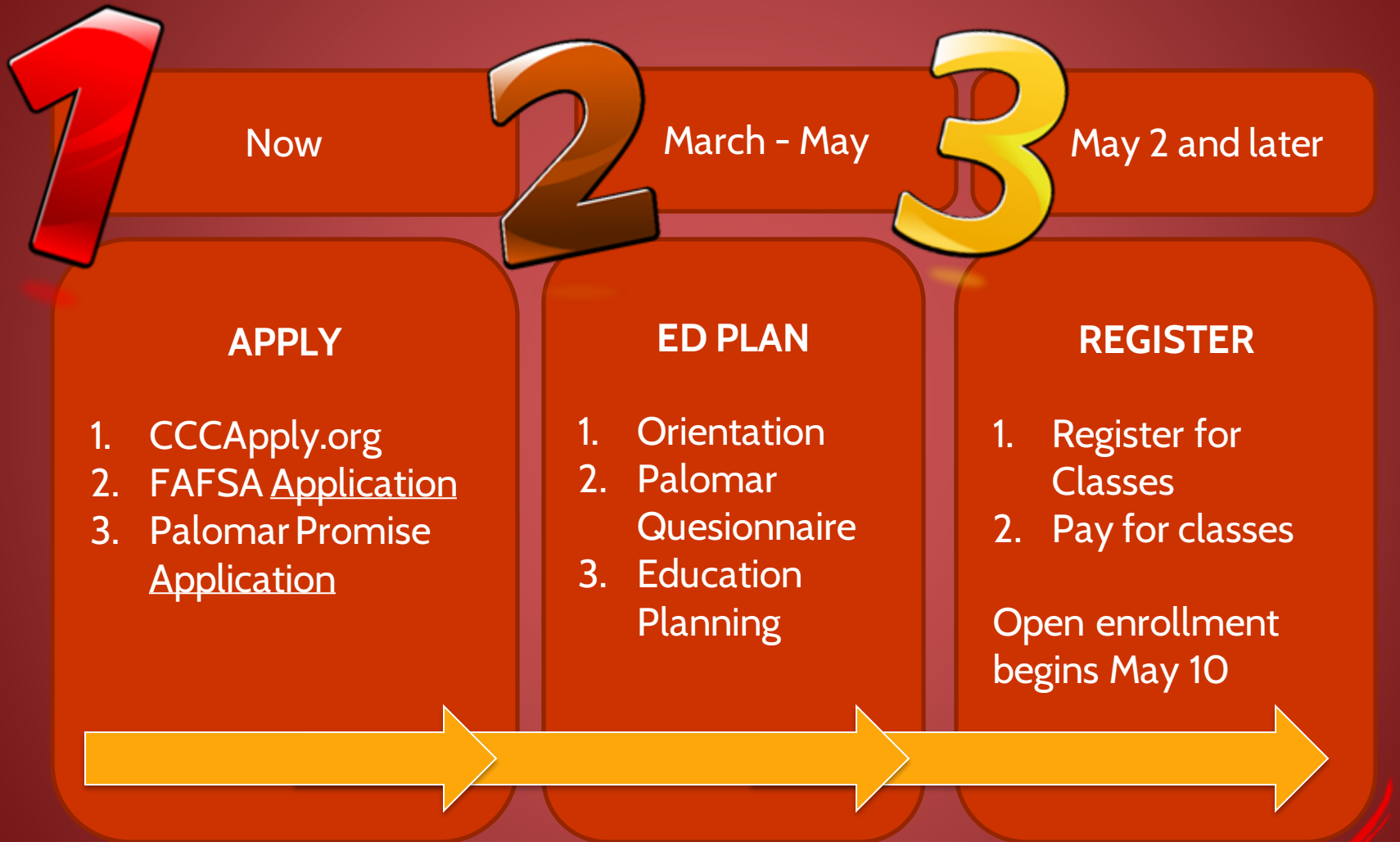

# Associate Degree Pathway

1. General Education	18-27 units
2. Major	18-45 units
3. Electives	If needed
Total Units = 60 units	

Courses #50 and higher apply to an Associate's Degree

# Bachelor's Degree Pathway

	Lower Division (Fresh, Soph)	Upper Division (Jr., Sr.)
1. General Education	39 - 51 units	0 - 9 units
2. Major	0 - 50 units	30 - 55 units
3. Electives	If needed	If needed
Total Units = 120 units

# What is an Education Plan?

- . A semester by semester course of study outlining a strategy for identifying and reaching your educational goals.
- . May include career planning activities and support tools
- . Developed by you and a counselor
- . Abbreviated ed plan
- . Comprehensive ed plan

# Ed Plans: Things to Consider



- Full-time school = 12 semester units = 3 to 4 classes
- 1 unit = 1 hour of class per week (usually)
- Study time/wk = 2 hours per unit
- Time on computer per week: 3 x units
- Work outside of school: Ideally < 20 hours/wk
- Synchronous or Asynchronous

- AREA C1 or AREA 3A course. Check My Class Finder for available courses.
- Suggestions: CINE 100, ART 100, DNCE 100 or 101, MUS 100, PHOT 125, TA 100

## **AREA E Courses for CSU**

- COUN 110, 115, 120, or 148, 165, READ 110 (any student)
- HE 100 (those interested in an Associate degree)

## **American History and Institution Courses**

(for Associate degrees or transferring to CSU)

- AS 101, 102, AIS 101, 102, CS 101, 102, HIST 101, 102, 140, 141, RS 102, 103, POSC 101, 102
