Coming to you once again with news regarding changes to our schedule. Out of continued concern with rising cases of COVID-19 even as we near the end of July, Palomar College has decided to continue with primarily online instruction on into Spring 2021. The health and safety of our college community is paramount in our consideration.

At this time, we will plan the upcoming spring semester to be online except for those programs included within the state's Essential Infrastructure Workforce listing and programs and courses associated with Public Health and Safety. Even within these programs, courses will continue to be offered online as much as possible.

Programs able to plan for partial face-to-face, on-campus presence for Spring 2021 are Police Academy, Fire Academy, EME/Paramedics, Nursing, Dental Assisting, BIOL 212, Cabinet and Furniture Technology, Welding, Diesel Mechanics Technology, Auto Body, Auto Tech, Air Conditioning, Water Technology and Wastewater Technology, and Drone Technology.

We await CCCAA (California Community College Athletics Association) guidelines to inform the way in which competitive Athletics and training programs may be offered.

The Instruction Office will provide updated direction this coming week so that our deans can begin work with chairs and ADAs as we shift our schedule building to address this most recent change. Doing so will allow us to be prepared well in advance of our late October start for Spring 21 registration.

The College continues to reserve the right to revise this schedule as dependent upon the status of the pandemic in our region. We will do our best to keep you updated as thoroughly as possible.
