## COVID-19 scenarios: What should I do if...







**Notify your Supervisor** 



**Consult your** Physician.

**Testing for COVID is** recommended\*



Do not return to the workplace until your symptoms are resolving and you have no fever without medication for 24 hours, even if you test negative

I tested positive for COVID-19





**Stay home** 



**Notify your** supervisor



Fill out the **COVID** Questionaire



You will be contacted to discuss next steps



Stay home until at least 5 days have passed from the date symptoms began or the date of your positive test (whichever occurred first). After day 5, you may return to campus if your symptoms have resolved or are resolving and you have not had a fever in the last 24 hours.



A mask must be worn until 10 days have passed since the date your symptoms began or your positive test, whichever occurred first.

If you are symptom free, you can return to the workplace.



Mask up around others for 10 days after exposure.



**Self-monitor for symptoms** and get tested 3-5 days after exposure\*





If you develop COVID symptoms or test positive for COVID, refer to the appropriate scenario above.


