



ExploreCSR@UC San Diego Introduction to Computer Science Research for Women

ExploreCSR@UC San Diego is a 15-week long workshop sponsored by Google, dedicated to providing Computer Science Research exposure to women and non-binary individuals in San Diego Community Colleges.

Through this mentorship experience, students will have the opportunity to:

- Interact remotely with a graduate student mentor in a team setting on a weekly basis and collaborate on a small research project with them.
- Attend the CSE Research Open House and engage with graduate students on the exciting ongoing research projects at UC San Diego.
- Present their work as a poster presentation at the CSE Undergraduate Research Symposium at UC San Diego in the first week of June 2020.

Interested students should be enrolled in or have completed a CS/IT/IS course to be eligible for participation.

Transportation and food for both on-campus events will be sponsored by a generous gift from Google. In addition to this, participants will get the opportunity to interact with undergraduate research students at UC San Diego, as well as researchers from Google.

At the end of the workshop, students who have successfully participated in most events** will receive a certificate and Google swag.

Applications open October 21, 2019 and are <u>due December 30, 2019</u>. All selected students will be notified via email by January 6, 2019. The workshop begins January 31, 2020.
