The proposed Military Leadership (MIL) Program will prepare United States Marine Corps (USMC) Sergeants to transition to Staff Sergeant rank within the USMC and to secure successful employment within the locally prominent military and defense industries after they exit service. The military and defense sector was responsible for nearly 340,000 of the San Diego region's total jobs in 2018, a number that is expected to grow in future years. More broadly, the local labor market demand for General and Operations Managers is also expected to increase, resulting in in-demand jobs for trained applicants. Enlisted Marines, who are disproportionately people of color, are required to have only a high school diploma upon entering the service, and experience lower socioeconomic status over the long-term than commissioned officers.
